**Priest Report:** Christine Salem, Jim Salem, Elizabeth Bartz, and Fr. Dean represented our parish at the Archdiocese Clergy-Laity Congress in San Diego. Book Club is continuing in August. Ministries are in full swing.

- Make people feel welcome
- Most of the new interested people are here early (8:15-8:30 a.m.)

Financials: Van Doros - Trust Fund - \$867,000, Building - \$136,000

A parishioner recently shared a nearly thirtyyear-old obituary with us. Although the name and circumstances are not relevant, the following words should resonate with many of us today:

"For all eternity, America is indebted to the immigrant mother, whether she was Italian, Jewish, Polish, Austrian, Hungarian, Saxon, German, Russian, English, Slavic, Greek, Syrian, Bulgarian, Czech, Irish, Slovenian, or Ukrainian. 
