

Dear Parish Family,

When I was a kid, my parents told me, "don't do that, it will become a habit." Habits like overeating or staying up too late can be bad for our health and safety, so we have to be mindful of not letting them form. On the other hand habits such as regular exercise or healthy eating can benefit us greatly. Good or bad, a new habit takes time and repetition. Motivational speakers often cite studies explaining that this process takes 21 days.

In the month of August, the Church offers us an opportunity to form new habits, or strengthen existing ones, concerning our prayer life and service attendance. In the first 15 days of the month, we will gather at the Church almost daily to pray the Paraklesis Service. We will ask the Mother of God for Her intercessions, both for ourselves and our loved ones. This is in addition to the celebration of the Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord, and our usual Sunday worship!

If we were to attend each of these 15 services, we would be twothirds of the way to a new or strengthened habit of daily prayer. Attending half would put us one-third of the way there. With so many unhealthy temptations in the world, why not take this opportunity to make prayer a new, or stronger, habit?

This month, let's commit as a family in Christ to prioritize prayer and attendance. Let's build a habit together that our parents wouldn't want us to stop!





We hear about our parish's free hot meals and groceries through the VOICE, our weekly Bulletin, and One Calls, but do we really know what this **Hot Meal** program is all about?

This month AXIOS is recognizing the group of parish volunteers who came together to organize and volunteer their time for the Hot Meal program, which provides a free nutritious hot meal to anyone who comes through our Church doors on the designated Hot Meal days. The second Thursday of each month features hot meals and a free clothes pantry, while the last Tuesday of each month provides hot meals the clothes pantry, and free

provides hot meals, the clothes pantry, and free groceries.

The program organizers/main volunteers are: John and Jen Matheos, Shannon Pangas, Myron and Kim Vernis, Ginny Dickos, and Karen Horattas. These dedicated folks are joined by a myriad of parishioners twice a month to help prepare and serve over three hundred of our less-fortunate fellow citizens each month. The high point of the program is the annual Thanksgiving meal, during which we serve over a thousand dinners.

The program, an integral part of our Good Samaritans Outreach Ministry, is entirely funded through an outreach line item in our church budget and the generosity of our fellow parishioners who donate to the Good Samaritan

collection at church on the third Sunday of the month.

So we say "AXIOS" to this dedicated group of parishioners, with Father Dean adding "more helpers are always welcome!"


