During these 40 days, we have the opportunity to prioritize worshipping the Lord at Church as many as five times a week. However, many of us lead busy lives and may not be able to do this. But it's Lent. We are supposed to try to do more. So, where do we begin?

Hopefully, we can all Come to Church for Liturgy on Sunday. But the splendor of that service stays largely the same throughout Lent. However, from February 25, even before Lent begins, the service of Matins contains hymns that highlight the themes of prayer, fasting, and repentance.

During these 40 days, we have many chances to prioritize coming to Church a little more often. But, if nothing else, arriving before liturgy begins on Sundays allows us to experience magnificently sung texts that will energize us throughout this spiritual race.

Lent is a time to increase the intensity of our spiritual lives. Come to Church as often as you can. But, at the very least, set the alarm backward an hour for 40 days and Come to Church for Matins!



The Surgeon General of the United States has found that there is an epidemic of loneliness in the United States. The causes are multifactorial. The rise of digital communication and media – we text and email, instead of calling, writing letters by hand and gathering in one another's homes. Demanding jobs and employers trying to squeeze the last bit of productivity from us, as well as our over-packed schedules that leave us drained, without the margin in our lives to invest in one another. The pandemic added to physical isolation and a change in habits that has created additional layers of physical and psychological distance between one another.

The Apostle Paul tells us in Hebrews 10:24 & 25, "24 and let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, 25 not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." This is part of what Fr. Dean frequently reminds us, by saying 'come to church.' We need one another to worship together, to fellowship and encourage one another, and to serve together.

And for anyone in the health professions, this is what our HUMS (Holy Unmercenary Medical Society) is all about. We meet periodically for fellowship and to support one another sharing not only our common profession of healing, but our common faith as well. We have opportunities to hear speakers from among our fellow parishioners and from outside, to not only learn health related information, but to hear how that person brings their faith to their work every day. We have health-related spiritual book studies to help us grow. And there are opportunities to serve, through educating our community and through such things as blood pressure reading checks during our food ministries to the poor.

If you are involved in a healing profession (physician, nurse, pharmacist, mental health professional, rehab therapist or medical social worker), please join our group and take advantage of the support that you can both receive, and provide to fellow Christian healers.
